IFN Conditional Text enables you to maintain a set of documents with minor variations instead of maintaining multiple versions. A data sheet that varies for several products or releases may be maintained as one document. Text that is conditional for a particular product or release is marked, viewed and published in different versions by displaying only relevant text and hiding non relevant text.

- **Faster documentation development**

Write text common to several document versions only once.

- **Easier documentation maintenance**

Information can be updated once in a document that is used for several different variations.

- **Reduced engineering effort for proofreading**

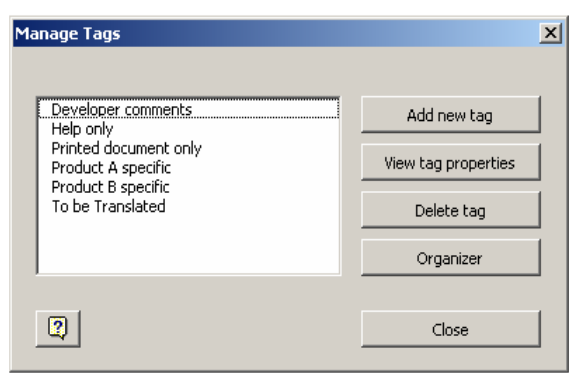
Content will be proofread by technical staff only once, even if used in many variations to deliver product-specific and release-specific documents.

- **Reduced translation costs**

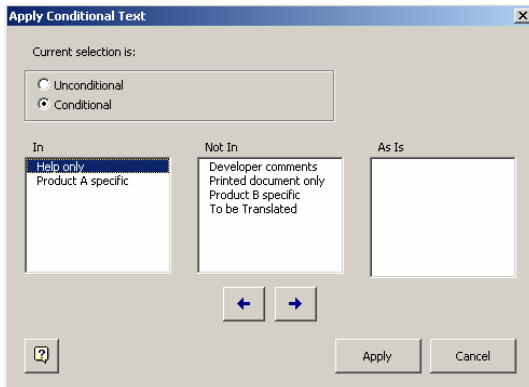
Content which is consistent over many different variations of the document will be translated once. Only text that varies will be translated.

Easy steps to efficient documentation

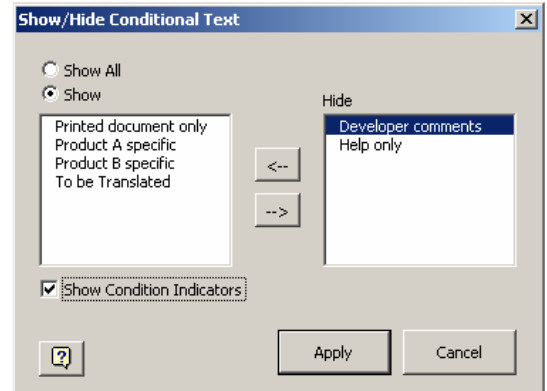
1. Create a conditional tag by opening the "Manage Tags" dialog box and click "Add new tag". A dialog box will prompt you to enter a name for the conditional tag and the highlight color to indicate that text is marked with this condition tag.



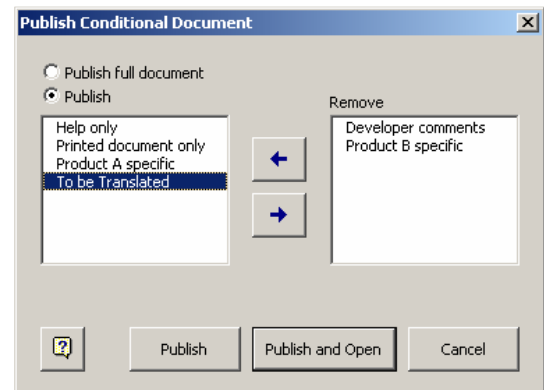
2. Apply conditional tags to text in your document, select the text in the document, and click "Mark Selection". A dialog box will appear allowing you to choose which conditional tags apply to the selected text.



3. Display and hide conditional text by clicking "Show/Hide Conditional Text". A dialog box allowing you to choose which conditions to display and which to hide will appear.



4. Publish conditional documents with only certain conditions displayed and all other text removed, click "Publish Document". A dialog box will appear allowing you to choose which conditions to include and which to remove.
